**Academics:**

- Seventeen Homerooms brought donations for the St Johns Homeless Coalition Supply for the drive organized by Student Council and Ms. Gavarrette. We were able to help many families in need and fully supply the student snack center. Donut awards went to Coles, Gavarrette, Stanton and Ms. Paton's homeroom classes.
- We had two students currently attending SJVS participate in the Wonder League Robotics Competition. They placed top 5 in the world in this competition for the 12-14 division.
- Three Landrum girls were selected for the American Association of University Women's 2021 Tech Trek Florida STEM camp for eight-grade girls – that is 3 Landrum girls out of 20 District-wide and 60 statewide.
- Ms. Pagliughi's Journalism students rocked another Jim Harbin competition. Six Landrum students placed in 4 of the 7 video categories and their work has been submitted to the regional competition.

- We congratulate Ms. Myer and 7 Landrum students whose artwork is currently on display at the 11th Annual All County Middle School Art Show at the St. Augustine Art Association. The work can be viewed online at the SJC website.

#### **Athletics:**

- The Landrum Sawgrass Varsity Tennis team had a winning season and beat Pacetti Bay Middle to clinch the Championship in St. Johns County for Middle School Varsity Tennis.
- The Landrum Competition Cheer Teams competed at UCA Nationals where the Small Junior High team placed 4th out of 12 teams from around the country and the Large Junior High team was ranked 5th in the nation.
- The Landrum Lions Varsity White team lost in the Championship but had a great season, 11-2. Four Landrum students made the 8th grade all star team.
