New Business:

Fund Request Brooke Jarrod presented on behalf of the ELA teachers requesting 329.67 for Scope magazines. This subscription last a school year and includes digital resources and print magazines. Students find the articles engaging and relevant. This is supported by the district and used by all ELA teachers at Landrum. This was unanimously approved by the group.

Mr. Ed Myers requested 6,715.00 to attend the National Science Teachers Association Conference in Minneapolis coming up in November. This would allow a him and two other grade level science teachers to learn about new science teaching initiatives. Question from Parent about what science labs look like in with new textbook just adopted last year and being used for the first time this year. Mr. Myers responded that the focus of teaching science is to encourage students to develop questions and investigate answers. This critical thinking has been called “sensemaking”. The memorization of terms and procedures was not an effective approach for students to engage with science curriculum. This new teaching structure leads to student generated questions and further discover. Called to a vote, one parent voted against, and the majority voted in favor.
