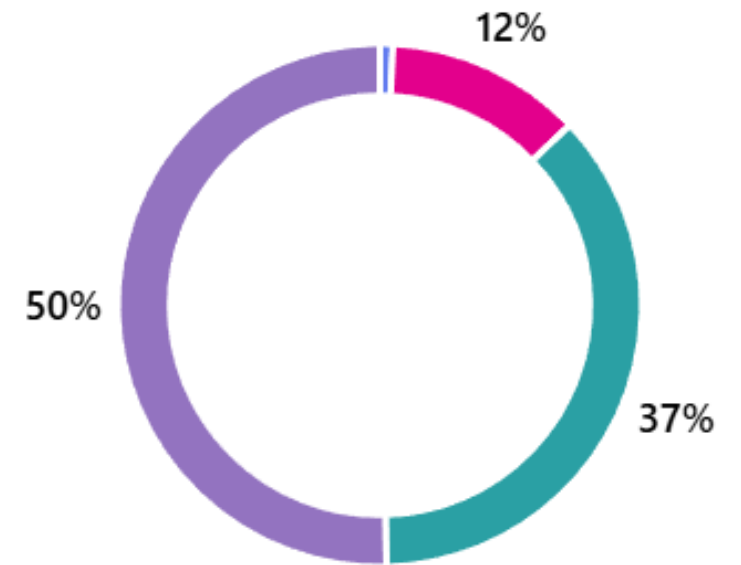

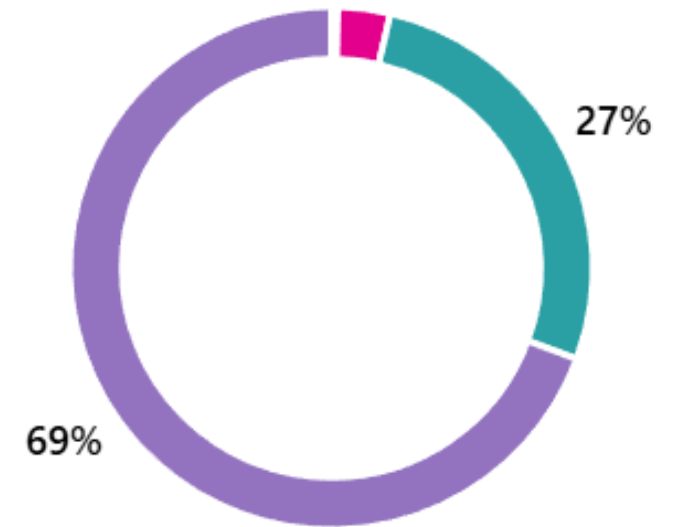

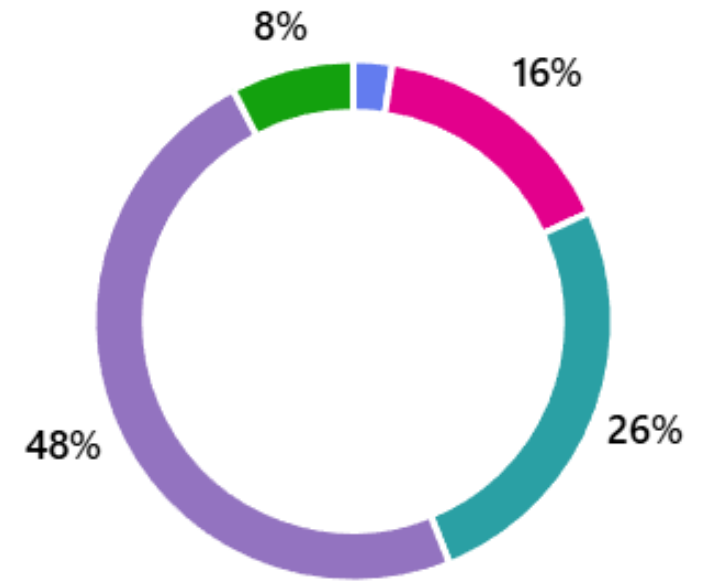

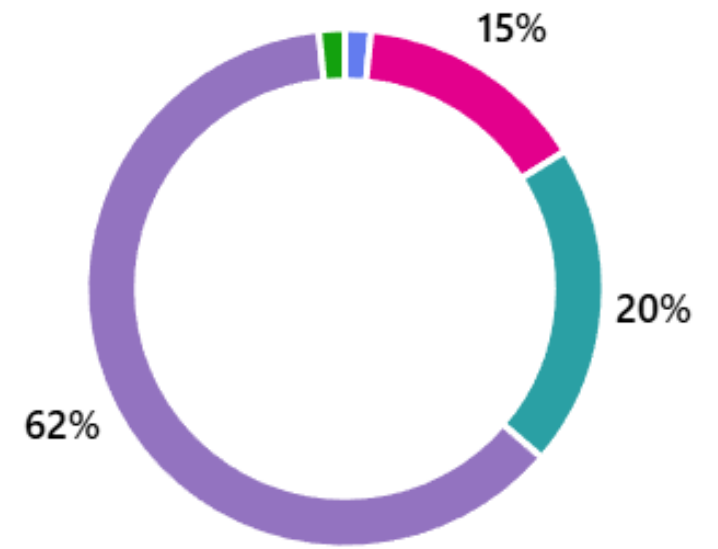

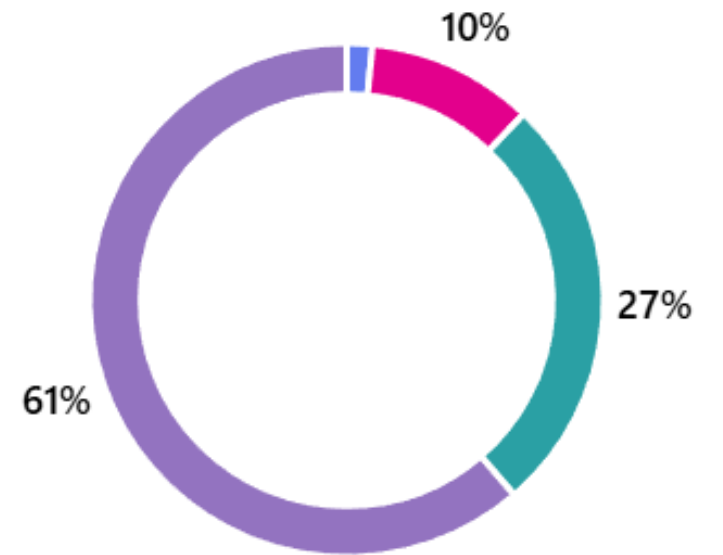

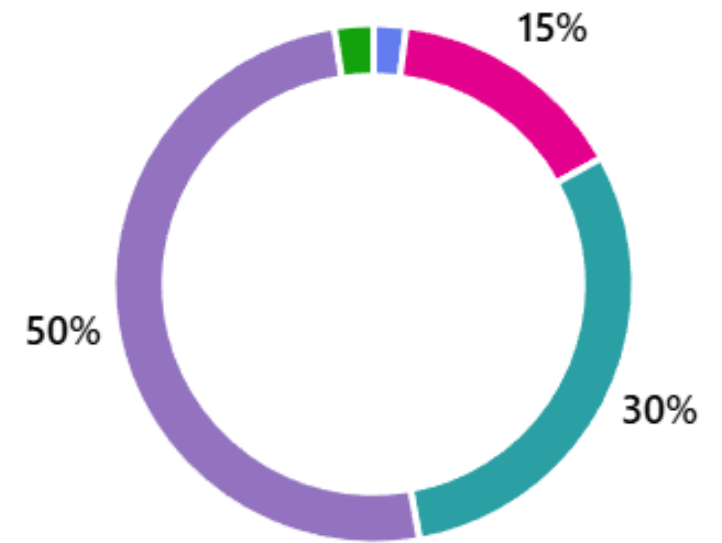

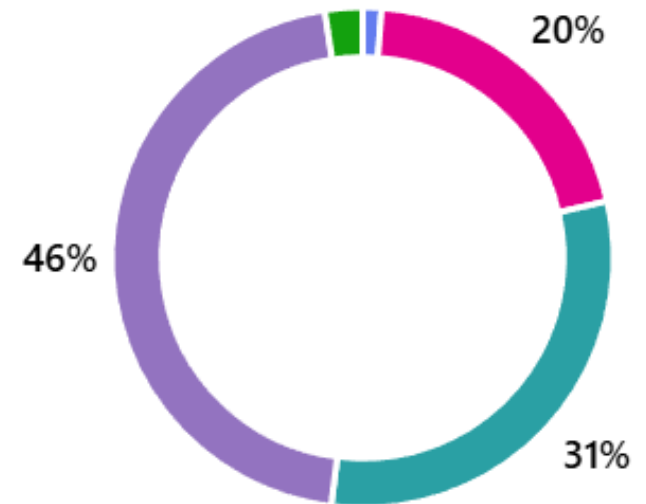

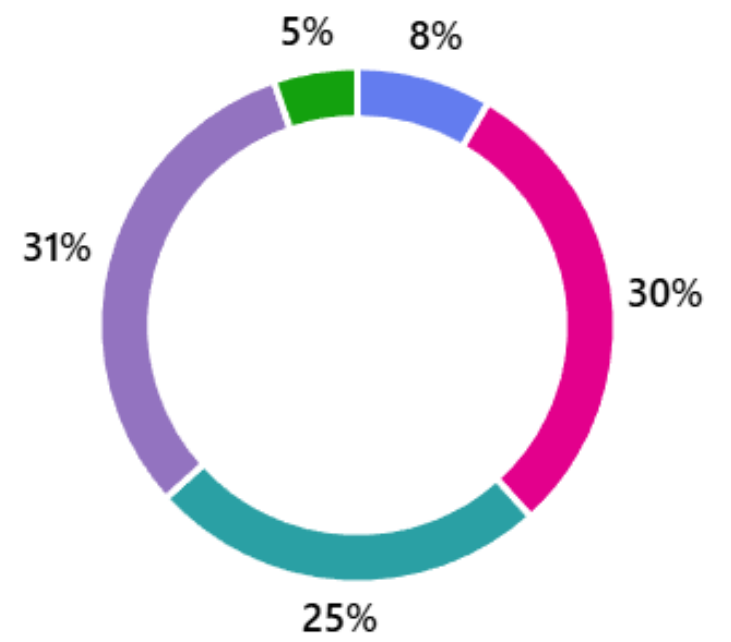

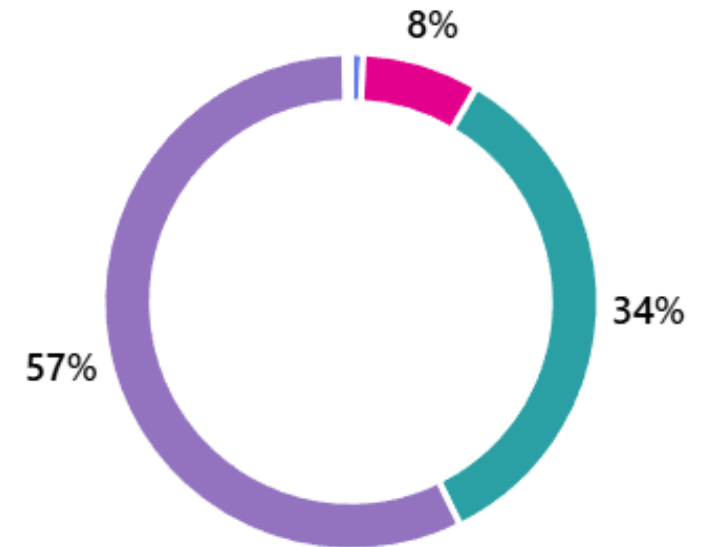

Overall Sentiment

- **Strongly positive overall**

- Most families are satisfied and describe Landrum as a **high-quality, supportive, and academically strong school.**

Overall Sentiment

- **Mixed but generally positive**

- Many families report a **good overall experience**, but with **more detailed concerns** than the first set.

Key Strengths from Comments

Communication

- Consistently praised as **frequent, clear, and responsive**
- Parents feel **well-informed and able to easily reach teachers/admin**
- Email communication is especially valued

Teachers & Staff

- Described as **dedicated, caring, and high-quality**

- Strong relationships between **students and teachers**

- Strong **sense of belonging and school pride**
- Students feel **supported, happy, and engaged**
- Positive peer relationships and respect among students

Extracurriculars & Programs

- Wide variety of **clubs, sports, and activities**
- Strong programs highlighted:
 - Band (frequently praised)
 - STEM
 - Speech & Debate
- High **parent involvement and PTO support**

Safety

- Many feel the school is **safe and secure**
- Some appreciation for policies (e.g., phone policy enforcement)

Parent Survey Results (AI Summary)

Most Common Concerns in Comments

📧 Communication (Most Frequent Theme)

- Strength: Frequent updates and accessibility
- Challenges:
 - **Too many messages (ParentSquare overload)**
 - **Inconsistent response times** from teachers/admin
 - Need for more **personalized, meaningful communication**
 - Lack of clarity on **who to contact**
- 👉 *Key need: Improve quality, consistency, and targeting of communication*

⚠️ Bullying, Behavior & Discipline

- One of the most significant concerns:
 - Reports of **bullying not consistently addressed**
 - **Classroom disruptions** impacting learning
 - **Inconsistent rule enforcement**
- Some families feel behavior issues are **increasing or not taken seriously enough**
- 👉 *Key need: Stronger, more consistent discipline and proactive behavior management*

👩‍🏫 Inconsistency in Teacher Quality

- While many teachers are excellent:
 - Some concerns about:
 - **Engagement and effectiveness**
 - Over-reliance on **technology vs. direct teaching**
 - **Lack of responsiveness**
- Mentions of **teacher turnover and morale issues**
- 👉 *Key need: Greater consistency in instructional quality across classrooms*

🏫 Policies Impacting Student Experience

- Most notable issue: **Assigned lunch seating**
 - Widely viewed as **outdated and socially harmful**
- Other concerns:
 - **Dress code enforcement inconsistencies**
 - Device and classroom management policies
- 👉 *Key need: Reevaluate policies for fairness, relevance, and student well-being*

🏈 Athletics, Activities & Recognition

- Strong desire for:
 - More **sports opportunities (e.g., JV teams)**
 - Better **recognition of all student activities**, especially **SJMSSAA sports**
 - Increased **school spirit and inclusivity**
- Perception of **unequal recognition across programs**
- 👉 *Key need: More inclusive and visible extracurricular support*

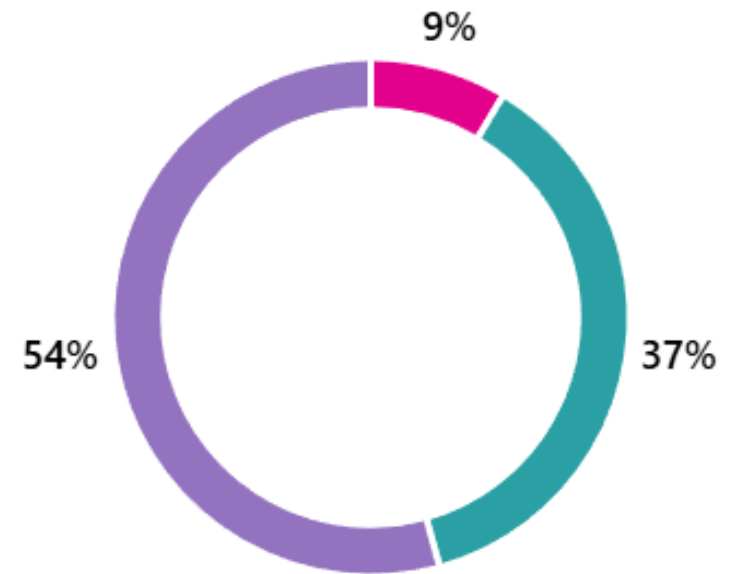

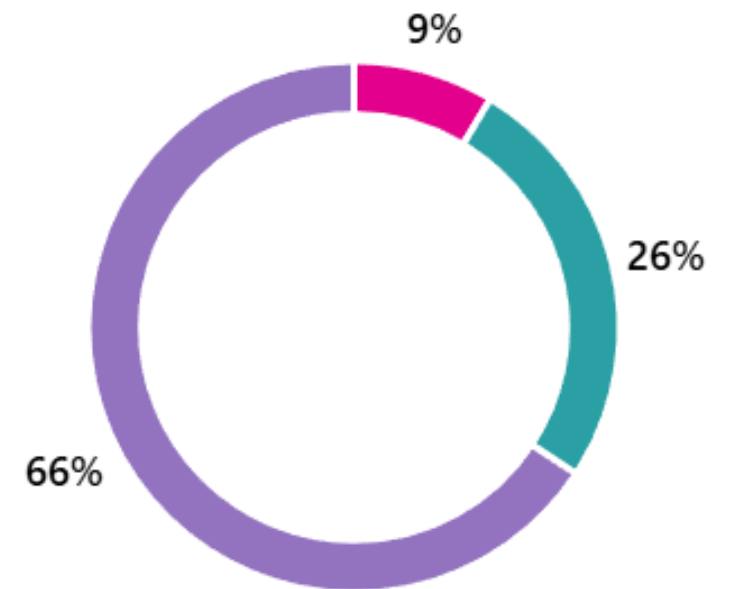

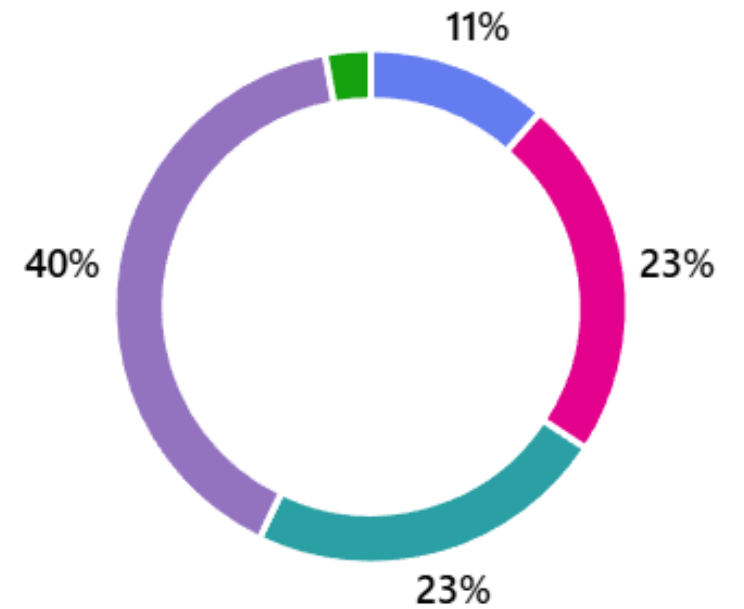

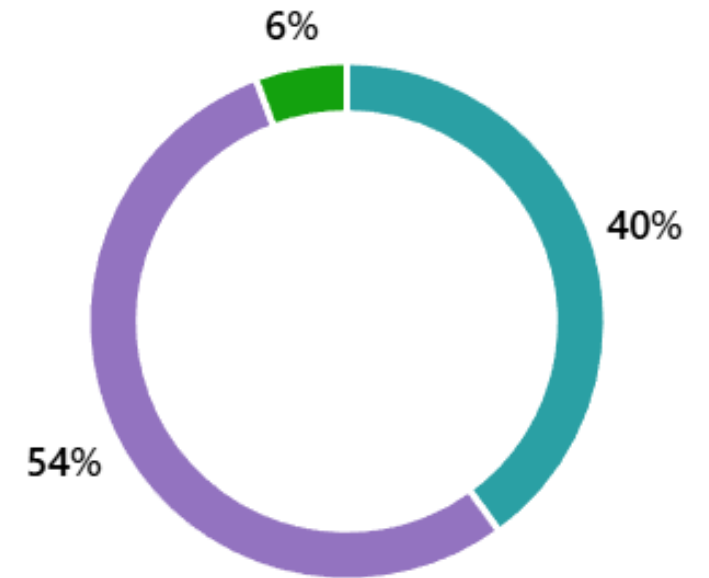

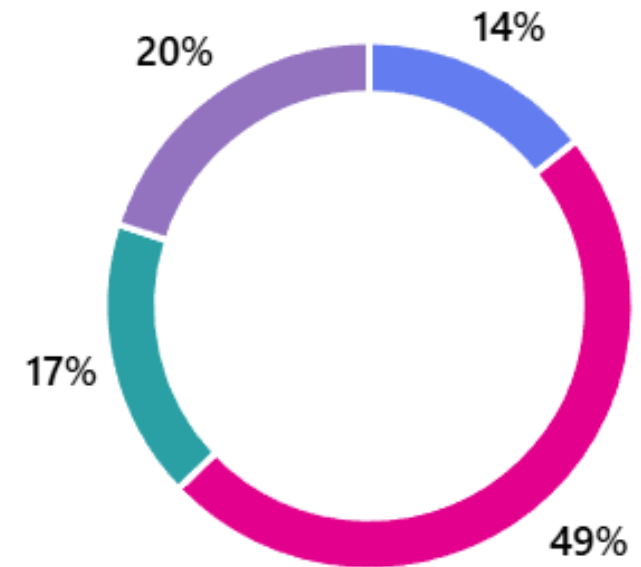

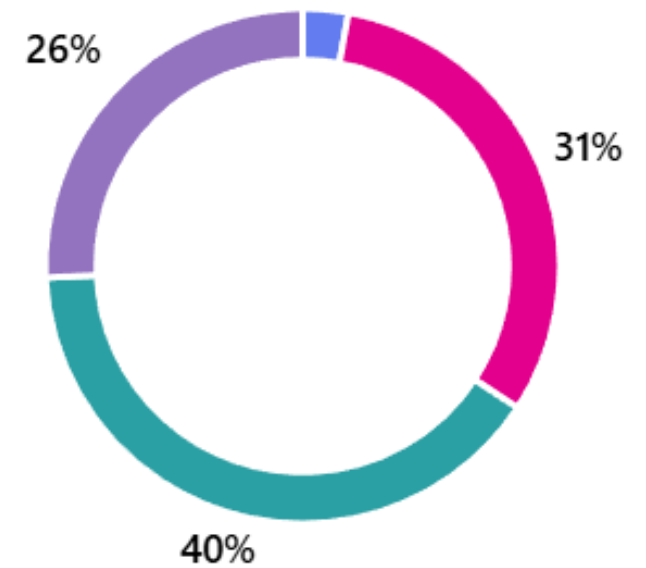

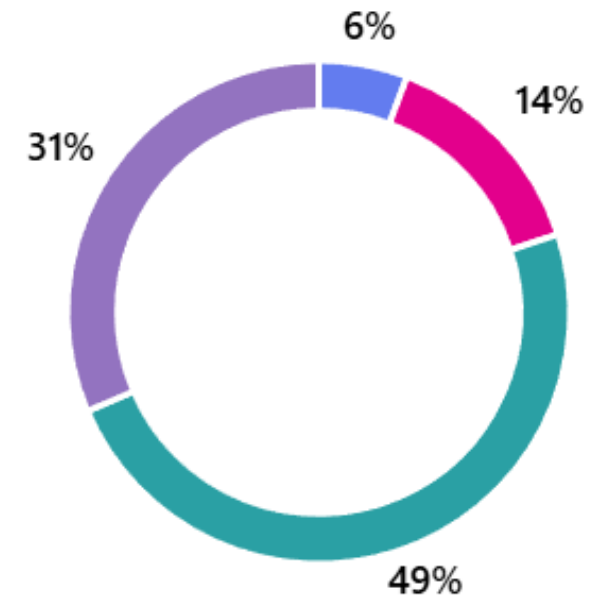

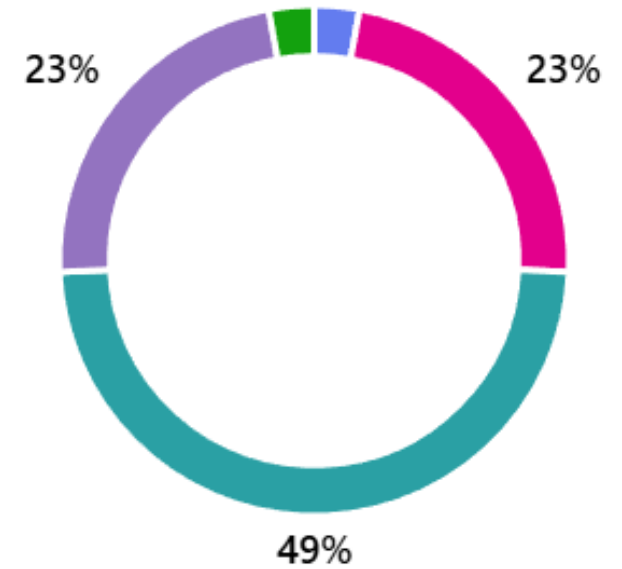

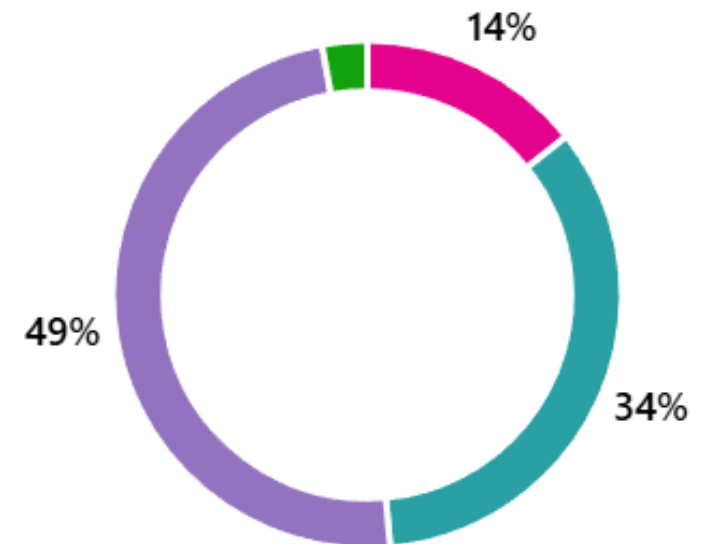

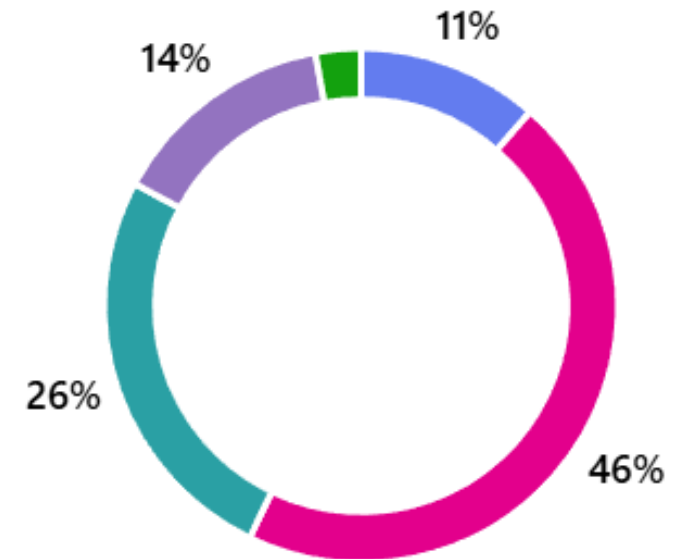

Overall Sentiment

- Very positive overall, with strong pride in the school
- Staff describe Landrum as a supportive, collaborative, and student-centered environment

Overall Sentiment

- Predominantly negative/concerned
- Main theme: frustration with administration communication, inclusion, and morale
- Some positive remarks about staff culture and individual interactions, but outweighed by systemic concerns

Faculty Survey Results (AI Summary)

Key Strengths from Comments

Strong Staff Culture & Collaboration

•Frequent mentions of:

- Supportive, caring, and welcoming staff
- Strong teamwork and camaraderie
- Teachers helping each other and sharing ideas

•PLCs (Professional Learning Communities) seen as valuable and supportive

•Staff feel comfortable seeking help from colleagues

Student-Centered Mindset

•Staff are:

- Deeply committed to student success
- Focused on meeting individual student needs
- Maintaining rigorous and engaging instruction

•Strong sense that teachers prioritize students above all

Positive School Culture

•Landrum described as:

- “Welcoming,” “caring,” and “phenomenal”
- A place with strong community and pride (“Landrum is love” repeated)

•Positive relationships among:

- Staff, students, community

Dedicated & Skilled Teachers

•Teachers viewed as:

- Hardworking and highly dedicated
- Skilled and collaborative

•Strong effort to maintain high academic standards

Support Systems

•Strong appreciation for:

- PTO support (financial and morale)
- ILC and internal support systems
- Administration (notably AP recognition)

•Staff feel supported both professionally and personally

Programs & Offerings

•Positive mentions of:

- Electives variety
- Band program

•Recognition of student achievement and success

Environment

•School described as:

- Clean and safe
- High-performing in academics and test scores

Faculty Survey Results (AI Summary)

Most Common Concerns in Comments

Repeated concerns about:

- Lack of communication from administration, last-minute notifications about events, and staff learning about events after parents/community

•Communication described as:

- Inconsistent, unclear, or nonexistent & lacking follow-through

Impact: Staff feel uninformed, unprepared, and undervalued

Lack of Staff Voice & Inclusion

•Strong concern that:

- Teachers are not consulted in decisions & input is ignored or not reflected

•Desire for:

- Shared leadership model & more teacher involvement in planning and decisions

Impact: Reduced buy-in, ownership, and trust in leadership

Low Morale & Staff Culture Concerns

•Reports of:

- Declining morale, feelings of being undervalued, excluded, or like an afterthought, and growing apathy among staff

•Some mention the school no longer feels collaborative or “ours”

Impact: Risk to staff engagement and retention

Need for Collaboration & Community

•Requests for:

- More structured collaboration time, regular faculty meetings, stronger staff community and connection

•Some positive notes:

- Many still see colleagues as supportive and welcoming

Gap: Strong peer support exists, but lacks system-wide structure/support

Leadership Visibility & Support

•Desire for:

- Admin to be more visible beyond main areas
- More presence in classrooms and daily school life

•Concerns about:

- Inconsistent expectations and follow-through & weak systems for behavior and accountability

Systems & Processes

•Concerns about:

- Unclear professional development processes
- Inconsistent teacher evaluations
- Lack of clear procedures for discipline and documentation

•Result:

- Teachers feel efforts to enforce expectations are ineffective

Resources & Tools (Minor Theme)

•Complaints about:

- Ineffective laptops/technology impacting productivity

Positives Noted

•Staff described as:

- Supportive, friendly, and collaborative (peer-to-peer)

•Pride in:

- The school overall & dedicated teachers and welcoming environment
